INSTRUCTIONS: This form is used by a candidate for nomination who wishes to remove the candidate's name from the primary election ballot. This withdrawal must be received by the official with whom the Declaration of Candidacy was filed not later than **NOON, February 10, 2023**. A candidate who has moved out of the election district, has been convicted of a felony or violating any other law that would prohibit the person from remaining a candidate, is on active duty in the U.S. Armed forces or subject to the Hatch Act or Little Hatch Act, and would violate federal law by remaining a candidate, or is a nonjudicial employee of a court who would violate the Indiana Code of Judicial Conduct by remaining a candidate may withdraw at any time.
